

# Wisconsin Veteran Related License Plates

Wisconsin women who have served in the military can now buy "Woman Veteran" license plates. The Wisconsin military plates feature blue numbers on a red, white and blue background with "Wisconsin" across the top and "Woman Veteran" at the bottom. A decal representing the veteran's military branch is displayed on the left side of the plate.



The state Department of Motor Vehicles now offers 56 different plates inclusive of 11 military plate options for veterans and recipients of military medals and honors. Military plates are available to active, reserve or retired U.S. military members, military academy students or alumni. The cost for the new "Woman Veteran" plates is \$90 - \$75 for the basic annual vehicle registration fee and \$15 for the Veterans Trust Fund at the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs. The \$15 fee is charged when the plate is issued; subsequent annual vehicle registration stickers will cost \$75. The Veterans Trust Fund pays for programs and services such as job fairs, outreach efforts for veteran benefits and the new Veterans Welcome Resource Center scheduled to open next month in Madison. Personalized military plate plates cost an additional \$15 a year. Military plates do not carry special parking privileges.

## Disabled veteran



New design issued in July 2009



Design issued 1991 through June 2009

Available to persons with a disability that impairs the ability to walk and whose disability was incurred while in active U.S. military service. Available for autos, motor homes, motor trucks up through 8,000 pounds, and 12,000 pound farm trucks. Two distinct plate styles are valid if currently registered.

## Ex-prisoner of war



First issued in 1980

Available to former prisoners of war as certified by the Veterans Administration. Available for autos, motor homes, motor trucks up through 8,000 pounds, and 12,000 pound farm trucks.

<b>Plate expiration</b>	For auto registration: Any day of the year (365 days), based on first date of operation in Wisconsin. Motor home and truck registration: Last day of expiration month.

## Gold Star Family



Available to persons who have had an immediate family member die while serving in the United States Armed Forces. Available for autos, motor homes, motor trucks up through 8,000 pounds, and 12,000 pound farm trucks.

## Historic military vehicle



First issued in 2010

Available for historic military vehicles manufactured for use in any country's military forces. Vehicles that run on continuous tracks, or a combination of wheels and tracks, do not qualify. Must be 25 or more years old if imported from another country. The vehicle may only be used for special occasions such as display and show events. Motorcycle version available.

## Lao Veterans of America



First issued in 2001

Available only to certified members of Lao Veterans of America, Inc. Applicant must contact the Lao Veterans of America, Inc. for a Veteran's Certificate and license plate stickers before applying for this license plate.

Available for autos, motor homes, motor trucks up through 8,000 pounds, and 12,000 pound farm trucks.

Available for autos, motor homes, motor trucks up through 8,000 pounds, and 12,000 pound farm trucks. Two distinct plate styles are valid if currently registered.

Available to veterans of the U. S. Armed Forces who submit proof of eligibility. Available for motorcycles only. No special parking privileges are provided with the U. S. Veteran motorcycle plate. Both styles are valid if currently registered.
